## FACULTY UPDATE

Dr. James DeBoy presented a paper entitled *Assessment of learner outcomes in Health Science* at the 13<sup>th</sup> International Conference on Quality in Higher Education in Glasgow, Scotland in July, 2001.

Dr. Elaine Green resigned from Lincoln in the summer of 2001 to accept an administrative position at Chestnut Hill College. We are currently conducting a search for a new TR faculty member.

Professor Yvonne Hilton completed a TR internship at the Center for Rehabilitation at Wilmington Hospital.

Professor Hubert Lee gave 1-hour presentations on fitness and exercise to Dade Behring, Inc. and Coventry Health Care.

Dr. Judy Kinney gave 2 presentations at the Regional conference of the NJ/EPATR Association. In mid-November she will be on the National Committee (NCTR) to develop cut-off scores for a new certification exam (1 of 10 professionals). She is currently working on 2 articles for journal submission and co-writing a text book on TR and Mental Health.
