

SMART Board Basic Instructions with Unified Projector/SMART Board DH 322

Always Turn Off Projector

If you log in to access your H-drive, LOG OFF when you are done or computer will lock and others can access your files.

TROUBLESHOOTING:

- If computer is locked, restart.
- Small rectangular light on bottom right of SMART Board indicates connectivity with computer.
- If **solid green**, connection is good.
- If **blinking green**, connection may be intermittent.
- If **solid orange**, connection is off. Restart computer.

To Start:

Press space bar or turn on computer if off

Log in as "guest," no password

If accessing H-drive, use personal log-in and LOG OFF after class

To Turn on Projector and SMART Board

Press purple I/O button on left side of pen tray

Allow 3-5 minutes for projector to warm up

At opening screen, choose "Computer 1" using arrows and ENTER key

You should see the computer desktop

Use computer keyboard and mouse or use SMART Board as touch-screen monitor

For SMART Board features, use "Notebook" software

To Use Projection for PowerPoint:

Access presentation using computer or using SMART Board as touch-screen monitor

To Use Projection for DVD:

Use computer's DVD player, called Power DVD

Adjust volume with remote

When Finished:

If you logged in, LOG OFF

Do not turn off computer or SMART Board unless you are the last instructor of the day.
