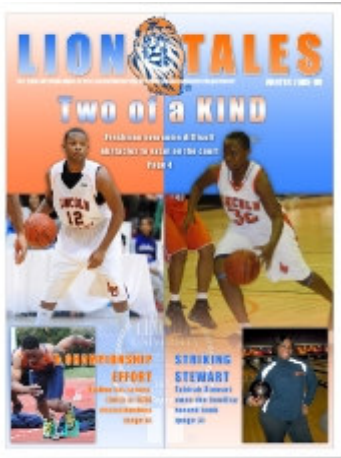

1. Refunds are an automatic process, verbal or written requests are not necessary.
2. Refer to the notification from your guarantor as to the loan amount and anticipated disbursement dates of your Stafford Loan.
3. If the amount of your Stafford Loan disbursement produces a credit balance on you student account, a refund will be mailed to you. It's automatic! Please hold your calls, it delays the process!
4. Please be apprised that the federal government allows academic institutions a window of TEN BUSINESS DAYS to process student refunds!
