The Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) requires that Reading Specialist candidates who possess an initial Instructional certificate must participate in an internship for a minimum of 100 hours. Internship responsibilities must be performed under the supervision of college personnel and cooperating teachers who are trained, have interpersonal skills, and demonstrate competence in teaching. Internships may be arranged in any of the six required Reading Specialist courses, with approval of the course instructor and a qualified, voluntary cooperating teacher.
