




### Canvas Tip Sheet: Pages



The Pages tool in Canvas is accessible by clicking on the plus sign in the Module title block or in the course navigation. Pages let you create interactive content directly in Canvas, whether it's a weekly update, a collaborative course wiki, or a list of educational resources. Pages can include text, multimedia, and links to files and other course content or pages. You can also allow students to contribute to specific pages in the course.

1. Add a Page to a Module	If you have not added Modules to your course, add a module to your course page. Then, click New Topic.</p>	<p>Add Item to Week 1</p>  <p>Add <input type="text" value="Page"/> to Week 1</p> <p>Select the page you want to associate with this module, or add a new page by selecting "New Page".</p> <p>[ New Page ]</p>
<p>3. Pages Name</p>	<p>Give your Page a name. Provide a descriptive name to help you identify the Page in the Pages index.</p> <p>Click Add Item.</p>	<p>Add Item to Week 1</p>  <p>Add <input type="text" value="Page"/> to Week 1</p> <p>Select the page you want to associate with this module, or add a new page by selecting "New Page".</p> <p>[ New Page ]</p> <p>Page Name: <input type="text"/></p> <p>Indentation: <input type="text" value="Don't Indent"/></p> <p>Cancel Add Item</p>
<p>4. In your Module, click on the Page you just created.</p>		 <p>⋮  <u>Welcome</u>  ⋮</p>

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<p>5. Edit Page Settings</p>	<p>In the right corner, click Edit.</p>	
<p>6. Begin to edit Page settings</p>	<p>If you need to change the name of the Page, you may do that here. Type your Page prompt</p>	
<p>7. Options</p>	<p>You may add to the student-to-do list, notify users that the content has changed. Then Save.</p>
