Integrity & Confidentiality Statement

In consideration of being allowed to serve as a member of a review committee, including PTS, DTC, FDRC and other related committees, hereafter “COMMITTEE”, I agree to be impartial in judgment and maintain the confidentiality of information.

As such, I understand and agree as follows;

- 1) I accept the responsibility to protect the integrity of the University and the COMMITTEE process.
- 2) I agree to promptly disclose to the Chair any appearance of impropriety or a conflict of interest that may bring into question my impartiality or the fairness of the work of the committee.
- 3) I will be fair, accurate, honest, and responsible in my deliberation of the issue before the committee.
- 4) I will guard against inaccuracies, carelessness, bias, and distortion made by either emphasis or omission of information.
- 5) I acknowledge that I will receive information as a consequence of my membership on the COMMITTEE that is not generally known outside of the COMMITTEE (hereafter “confidential information”). As such, I will adhere to the following principles:
- 6) I will respect the absolute confidentiality of all parties and witnesses. I will not reveal the identity or any other information about the parties or witnesses before or after the committee completes its work.
- 7) I understand that disclosure of confidential information could be highly damaging to students, employees, volunteers, the University, or others.
- 8) I consider the obligation of confidentiality and impartiality to be a matter of personal and professional responsibility. I understand that breaching this agreement may subject me to disciplinary actions.
