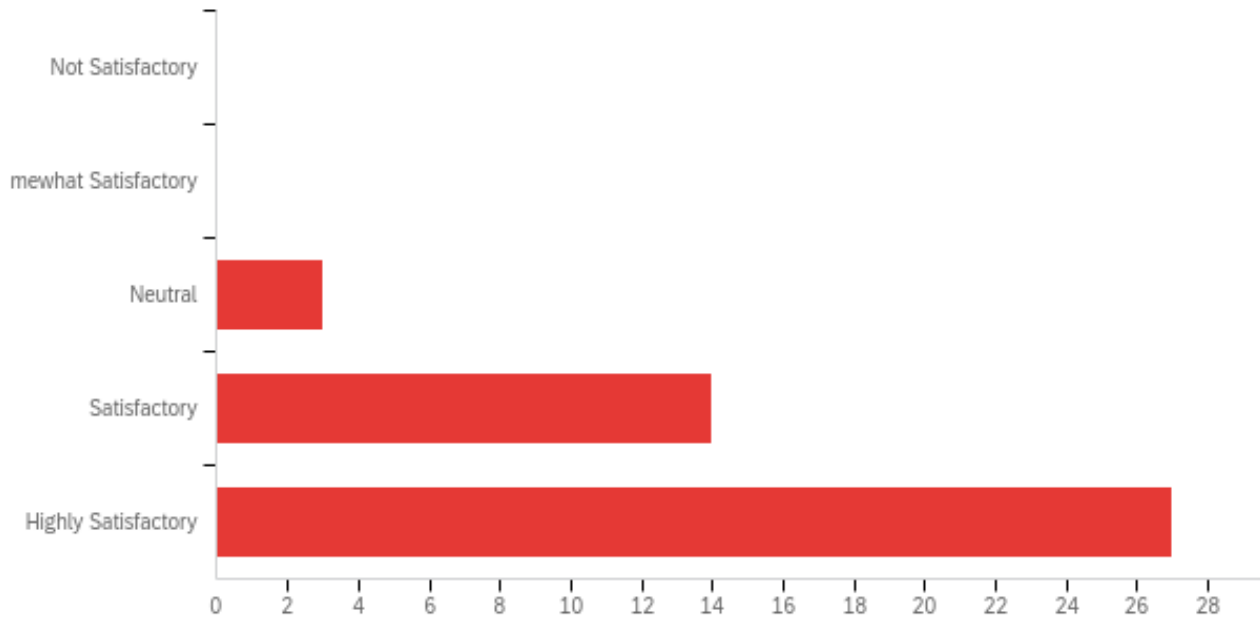

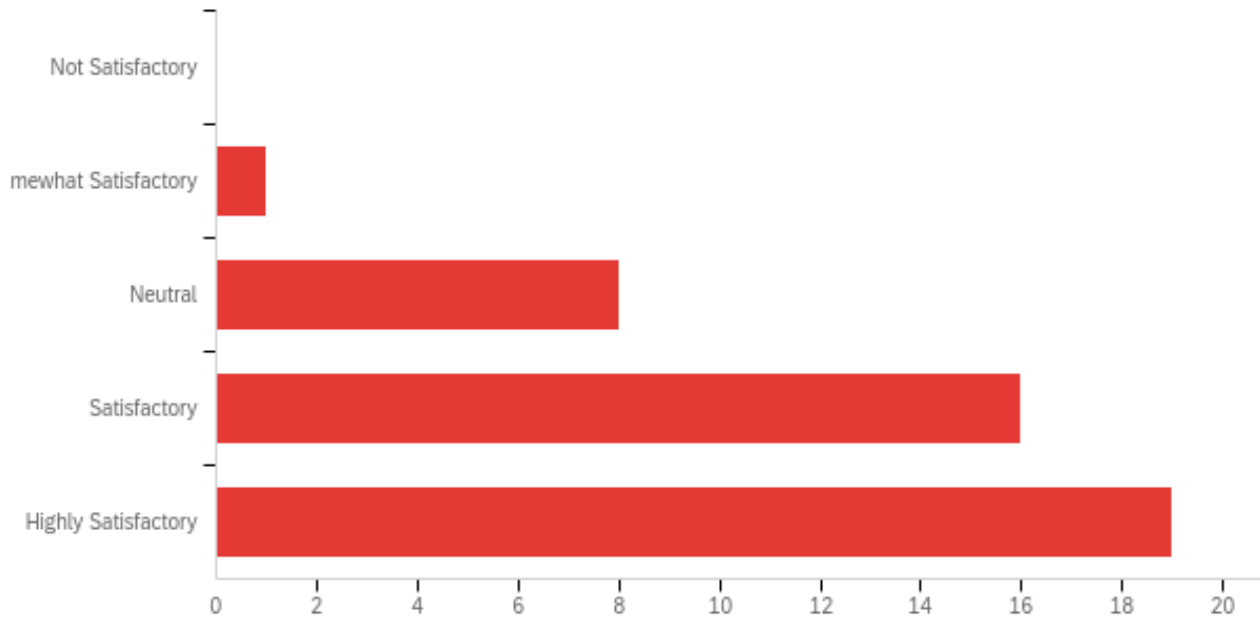

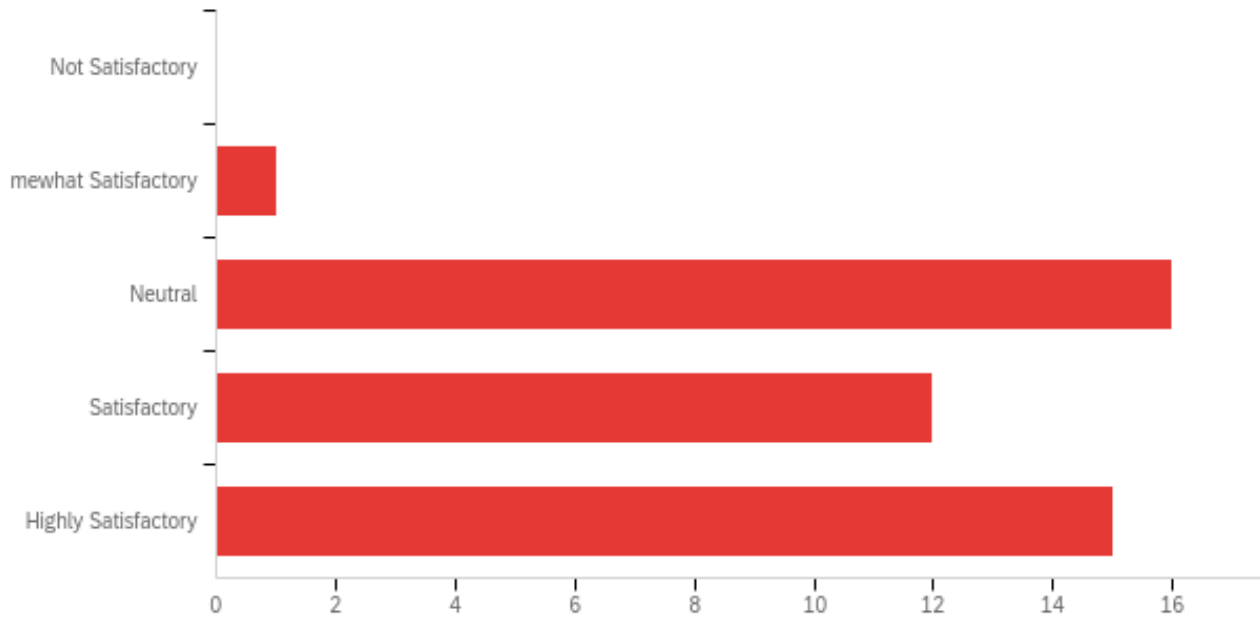

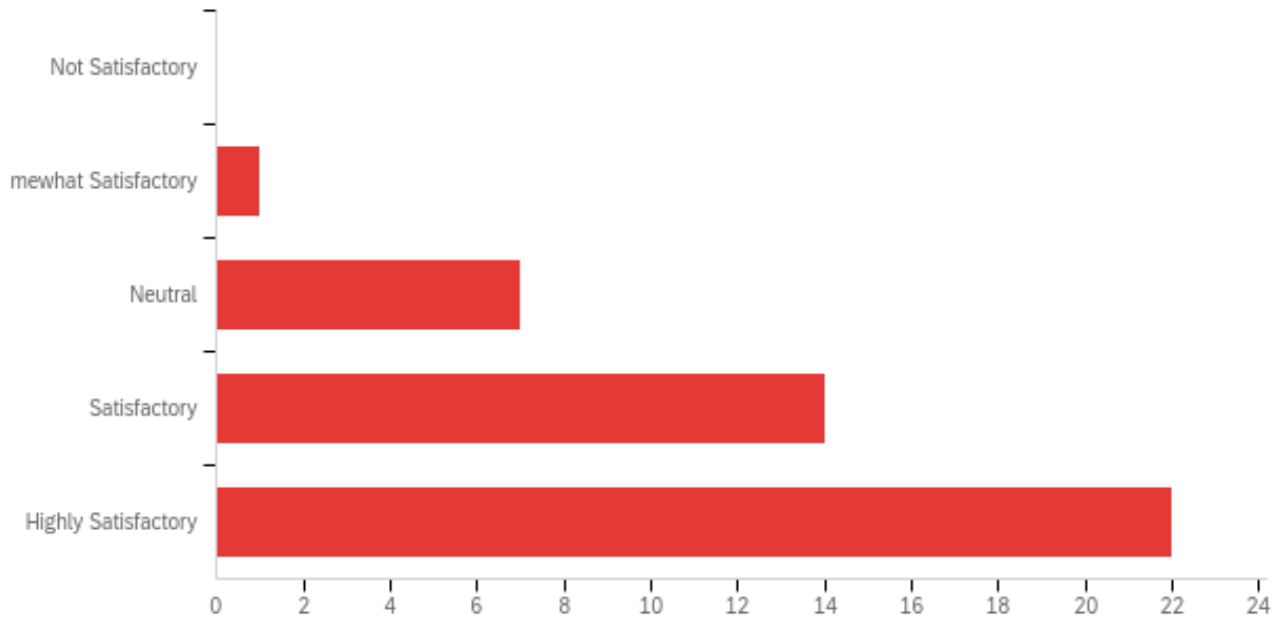
6. Stability of service (low

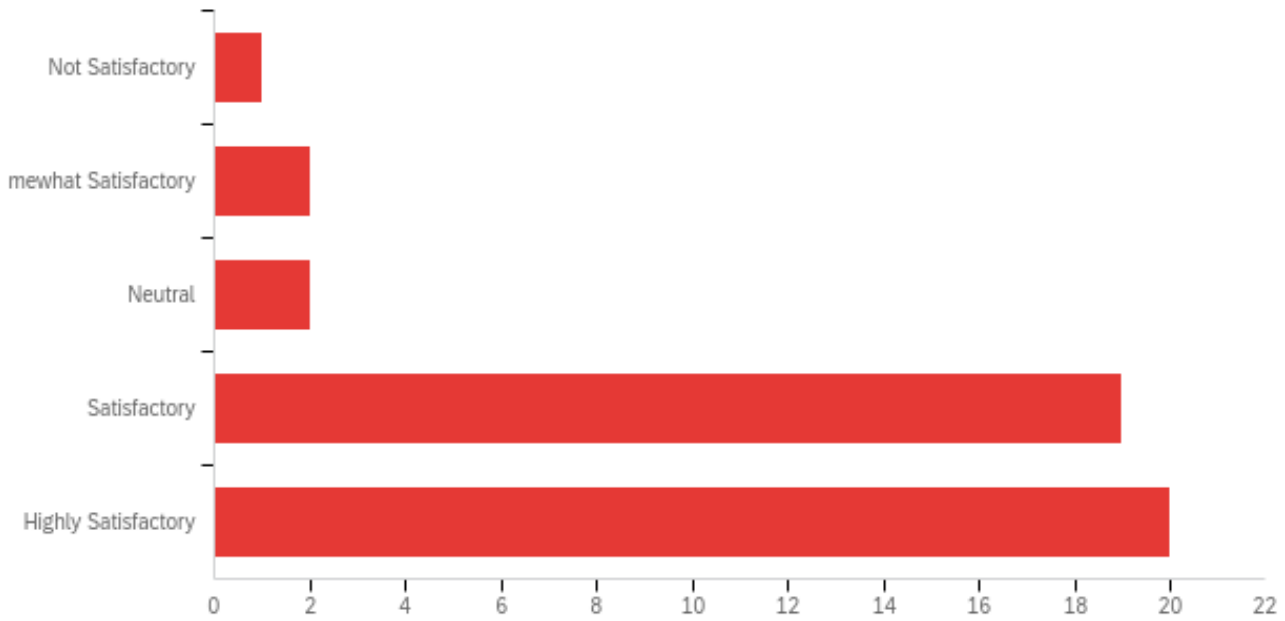

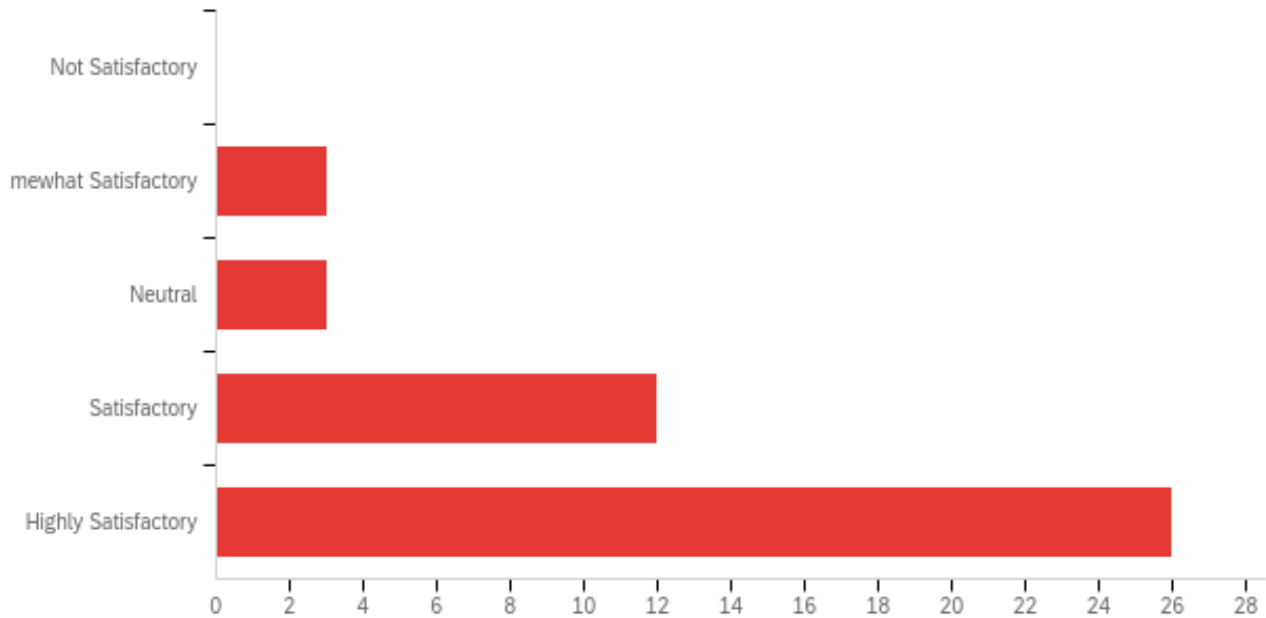

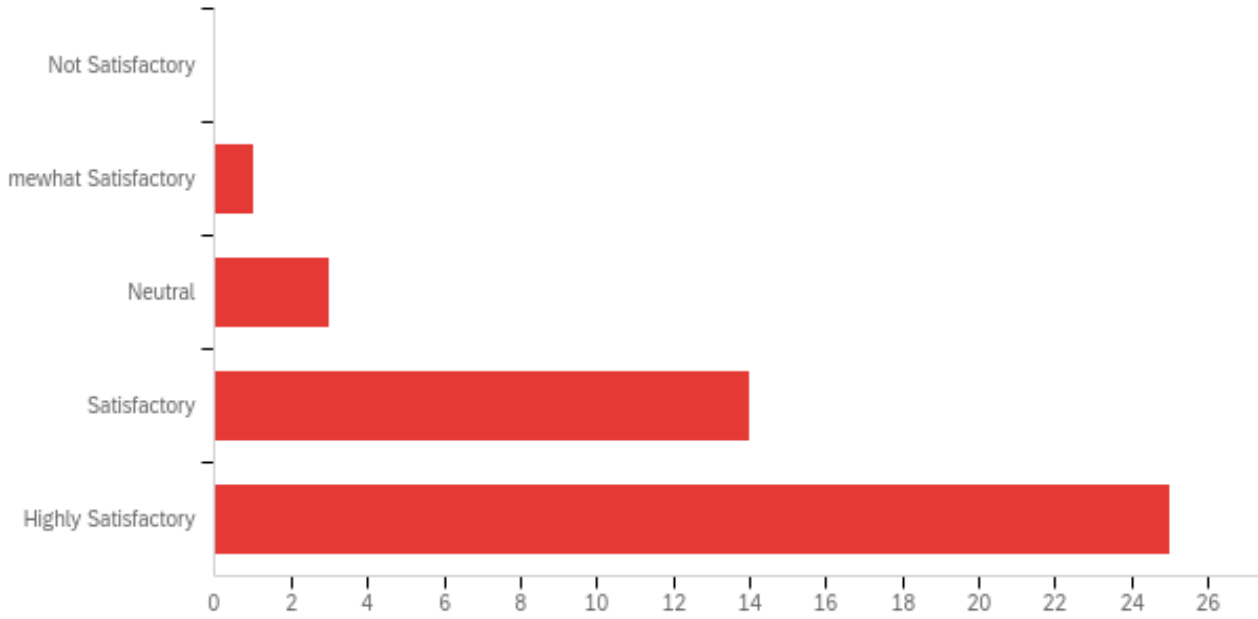

I have been using the free canvas platform for years. It is very user friendly and customization is great. Grading is wonderful with rubrics and feedback for assignments.

I was quite impressed with the instructor friendly tools and the class socialization that can occur. The Assessment feature will save lots of time.

Canvas gives instructors many different tools to conduct teaching and learning. If we shift to canvas, this should be done very soon so that instructors will have the summer to gear up for courses in the Fall.

Canvas looks great - user friendly and broad capabilities.

I used Canvas extensively when I taught at the University of Delaware, and it is a fine platform. However, I have to say that I don't know if it is all that much different than what I have seen in Moodle.....

Very adaptable and easy to use.

While I may not be able to fully assess all features of this LMS, it is my opinion that it would be highly inopportune to make the switch at this point in time. There is a number of reasons for that. One that first comes to mind, there is no clear advantage of Canvas over Moodle. Actually, according to some comparisons, Moodle has advantages over Canvas.

Navigation seems very easy and intuitive. Calendar and scheduling features are excellent. I like the ease of seeing and embedding YouTube videos.

My concern is the frequent changing from one system to the next. Did we have assessment data that showed that Moodle was not good enough?

Can it be linked to the library ILS?

Design simplicity: all the needed features are visibly/readily accessible on the main page.
