Requirements and Approval

Requirements:

An African American Experience Course must emphasize **Writing (ILO 1)** or **Critical Reading (ILO 5)** and use one of the following as the secondary ILO:

ILO 2: Technology and Information Literacy

ILO 3: Diversity Awareness and Cultural Awareness

The course must also align with at least three of the following SLOs:

Students will:

1. Identify the impact of the Trans-Atlantic slave trade on America's social, economic and political structures.
2. Demonstrate understanding of the civil rights movement and its impact on current social, economic and political conditions in America.
3. Describe the structure, style and leadership philosophy of at least two contemporary African America organizations (social, political, religious, educational and economic)
4. Explain the portrayals of African Americans in news and popular media trends.
5. Analyze one health, environmental or gender/class/identity issue affecting African America communities.
6. Synthesize the contributions of African Americans to the Arts, Sciences, Technology and economy of the United States of America.

Approval Process

- Submit the syllabus and one assignment to the General Education Committee, who will consult with The African American Experience Coordinators
