What is Registration? At Lincoln University, continuing student registration is the period in which all currently enrolled students should register. This registration period is intended to give preference to all continuing students by matriculation and class level, ensuring that they are able to schedule classes before new students. This date-regulated process ensures fairness to all students and provides them with the best access to our computerized registration system. Prepare For Your Advising Appointment

- Log in to <u>LU Self-Service</u>. Please note: You must be logged into your Lincoln email in the same browser to access LU Self-Service.
- Check for holds. If no holds, select "Start Here Student Planning".
- Review your transcript in LU Self-Service. Review your Midterm Grade
 Report. Review and Compare Your Progress in LU Self-Service with the
 <u>Sequence Sheet</u> for your Major (choose your sequence sheet based on the
 year you entered Lincoln, then search for your major).



- Click "My Progress." Search for preferred courses to add to your plan. Click add course to plan.
- In the drop down menu, select a term. Choose 2023 summer or 2023 fall term.
- Click add course to plan
- Meet with your advisor to discuss the course plan and release your holds
- When the holds are released, you may register for your classes
