Applications are reviewed on an individual basis. Candidates must then earn a 3.0 or higher during the first 12 credits to be considered for full admission. 	Ed. in Early Childhood Education Program requires: Students to pass 1 of 3 ECE PECT Modules at the PDE cut score or qualifying score (based on GPA) before enrolling in Student Teaching, EDU 501 or EDU 503. Students to submit 5 clearance documents. See detailed information below.
Th in cle fiel	DE Requirement for Clearances:  e Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) requires all personnel who come in contact with children school settings, including student teachers and education program participants, to have appropriat arances for the protection of children. All graduate education students will participate in school-based experiences which are required in 11 of 12 program courses. Therefore, all graduate students in acation programs must obtain the following 5 clearances, which must be current within one year:
	Pennsylvania State Police Criminal History Record. Request online <a href="https://epatch.state.pa.us/Home.jsp">https://epatch.state.pa.us/Home.jsp</a> Pennsylvania Child Abuse History Clearance. Request online through the PDE website. (It will take 10-14 days to receive the report in the mail)
	FBI - Federal Criminal History Record (Fingerprinting sites are available including some UPS stores. It takes about 10 days to receive the record.)
	Form PDE 6004 - a form developed by PDE to report prior arrests or convictions for any offense listed in Act 24, Section 111(e) of the School Code. Specific offenses are identified on page 3 of Form PDE 6004. Available from the Office of Student Services.
