

## The Lincoln University Office of Student Support Services Disciplinary Sanction Community Service Program D.S.C.S.

**Program Summary:** The Disciplinary Sanction Community Service Program supports the mission of the University by promoting community standards of behavior, personal accountability, conflict management and resolution, and civility. The program is designed to support and assist students who have violated the Student Code of Conduct by providing programs, activities and services that 1) enhance their social and personal development; 2) aid in the development of mature and ethical decision-making; 3) promote personal reflection; and 4) provide opportunities to give back to the University community and promote civic and social responsibility.

Students who violate the Student Code of Conduct and are sanctioned to serve community service are required to pass an online orientation within three (3) business days of receipt of their letter from the Dean of Students. Upon passing the DSCS orientation quiz, students must purchase a D.S.C.S. t-shirt in the Office of Student Support Services located in Wright Hall 1<sup>st</sup> floor from Mr. Suggs or Mrs. Manley on Mondays or Wednesdays only from 2pm until 4pm for \$10.00.

The following is a list of the most common community service and educational assignments given:

 Under the Influence - on-line educational course that helps students clarify their thinking about alcohol. Designed for 1<sup>st</sup> offense of alcohol related infractions.
 <u>Student Cost is \$40 Cash</u> and can be paid in the Office of Student Support Services located in Wright

- Marijuana 101 on-line educational course that discusses the consequences and realities of drug use. Designed for 1<sup>st</sup> offense of drug related infraction. Student Cost \$40 Student Cost is \$40 Cash and can be paid in the Office of Student Support Services located in Wright Hall 1<sup>st</sup> floor please see Mr. Suggs or Mrs. Manley on Mondays- Wednesdays from 2pm until 4pm
- University Community Assignment students will be assigned to work in various departments and/or
  participate in various campus wide initiatives (campus wide clean-ups, student dining hall clean-up, etc).
- Educational Forums students will be required to attend various workshops, forums, or panel discussions held by university departments and/or student organizations.
- **Reflection Meetings** mandatory monthly meetings held by the department to provide students with the opportunity to reflect on their specific situation and to explore their own personal decision making process.
- **Pre- and Post Reflection Supplements** students are required to complete all applicable reflection supplements before completion of the program.

- **Off-Campus Community Service** various off-campus community service opportunities held each semester. Transportation is provided and participation is mandatory.

**PLEASE NOTE:** If you fail to complete the conditions of your judicial sanction a Judicial Hold may be placed on your student account. With this hold in place, you are prohibited from participating in registration and course adjustment, requesting transcripts, and from receiving a diploma. The Judicial Hold is removed after the conditions of your sanction are met.
