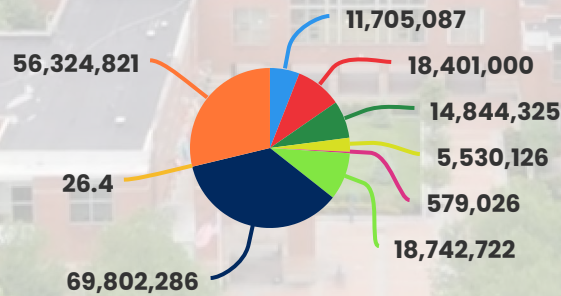

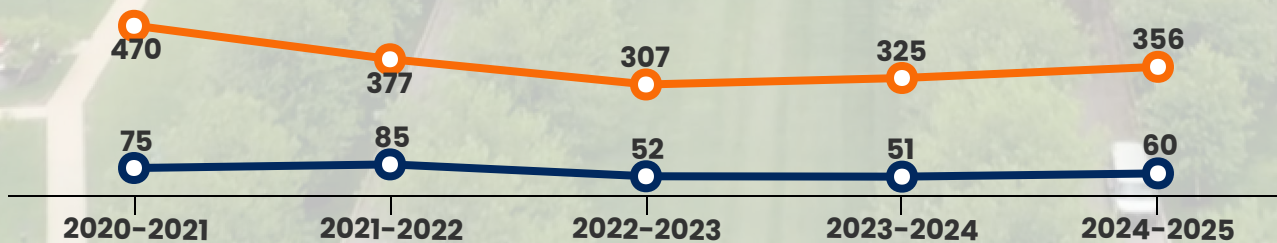

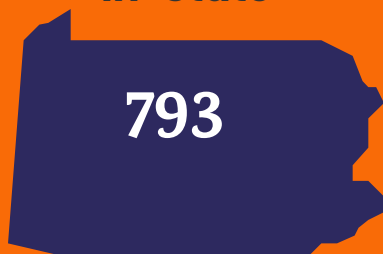

In-State



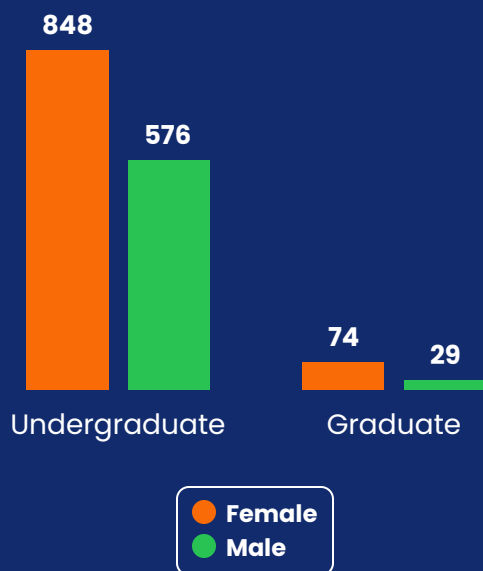
