- Help the campus understand **Pronouns**






MEASURABLE



Quantify or at least suggest an indicator of progress

- •Document and compare the number of PA applications started submitted and completed.
- Document the number of freshman returning each Fall as sophomores
- •Increase the number of participants in the presentations





ATTAINABLE

Determine if the goal is attainable - identify and assign ownership:



- Athletics Women's basketball coaches and team
- First Year and Transition Class Dean
- Title IX Coordinator








State what results can realistically be achieved, given available resources

- •3% increase in PA students enrolled
- Women's Basketball Championship
- •5% increase over previous years for returners
- •80 % participation in the Title IX presentations






TIMELY
