Note:

Undergraduate students entering Lincoln University in fall 2024 and beyond must complete the Lincoln Legacy Experience (LLE). This program is designed to advance both academic and personal development, connecting classroom learning with co-curricular activities. The LLE provides structured, supportive pathways from the first year through graduation. These experiences ensure students are well-prepared for graduate education, professional careers, and societal contributions.

An LLE e-portfolio is a graduation requirement for all students who entered the university during the fall 2024 semester and beyond.

Note:

The Bachelor of Arts and the Bachelor of Science students who complete any foreign language course numbered 2002 or higher may receive a Bachelor of Arts degree. This is commonly achieved by completing four semesters of a foreign language. There is no University requirement for foreign language for the Bachelor of Science, but certain majors may require one year of a foreign language.
