As we prepare for Lincoln University's **100th Homecoming Celebration**, you are invited to participate in the dates of the upcoming event(s):

Merchandise & food vendors interested in vending during Homecoming (Thursday, October 22nd to Saturday, October 24th) may do by submitting a vendor application no later than **FRIDAY, OCTOBER 2, 2026**.

Upon approval, you will be directed to pay the appropriate fee as stipulated by the attached Vendor Application Form by **FRIDAY, OCTOBER 9, 2026**. **Due to potential changes in our vendor set-up process**, there may be a limited number of spaces available this year for vendors; however, diligent attempts will be made to accommodate as many as possible. We are inviting you to participate each day; however, if you cannot, please let us know which days you plan on attending, by completing that section on the application. **Please note that there is not a separate fee per day.**

As a reminder, food vendors must secure a certificate of liability insurance no later than Monday, October 19, 2026. Vendors can participate during the following times:

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 22 ND :	set-up 9:00 am – vending starts at noon
FRIDAY, OCTOBER 23 RD :	set-up 9:00 am – vending starts at noon
SATURDAY, OCTOBER 24 TH :	Vending starts at 11:00 am and concludes at 12:00 am.

**** Unfortunately, tables are not provided, but each vendor is allowed to bring up to two (2) tables. ****

Vendors are not allowed to park in the vending area, cars are only permitted to load/unload in the space. Public safety will ticket and/or tow your vehicle if you fail to follow parking regulations on campus. Vendors are responsible for appropriate cleanup and disposal of all materials.

Vendors selling merchandise with any Lincoln logo, seal, or mark must be licensed via CLC Brand Manager. All merchandise with logo, seal, or mark will need to be pre-approval through CLC. Please note that vendors who fail to submit payment or obtain their licensing by the deadline will not be permitted to vend and will lose their spot.
