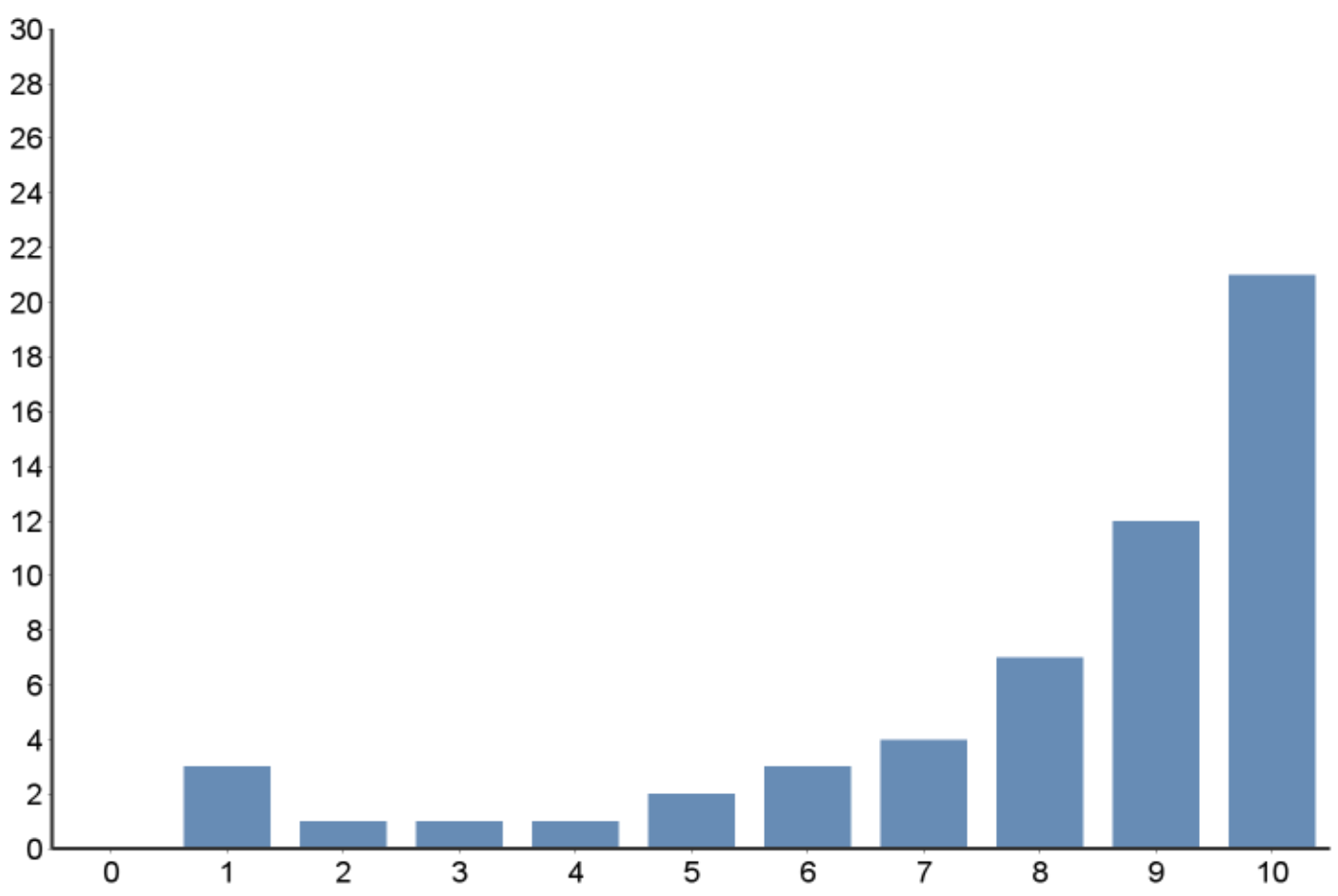

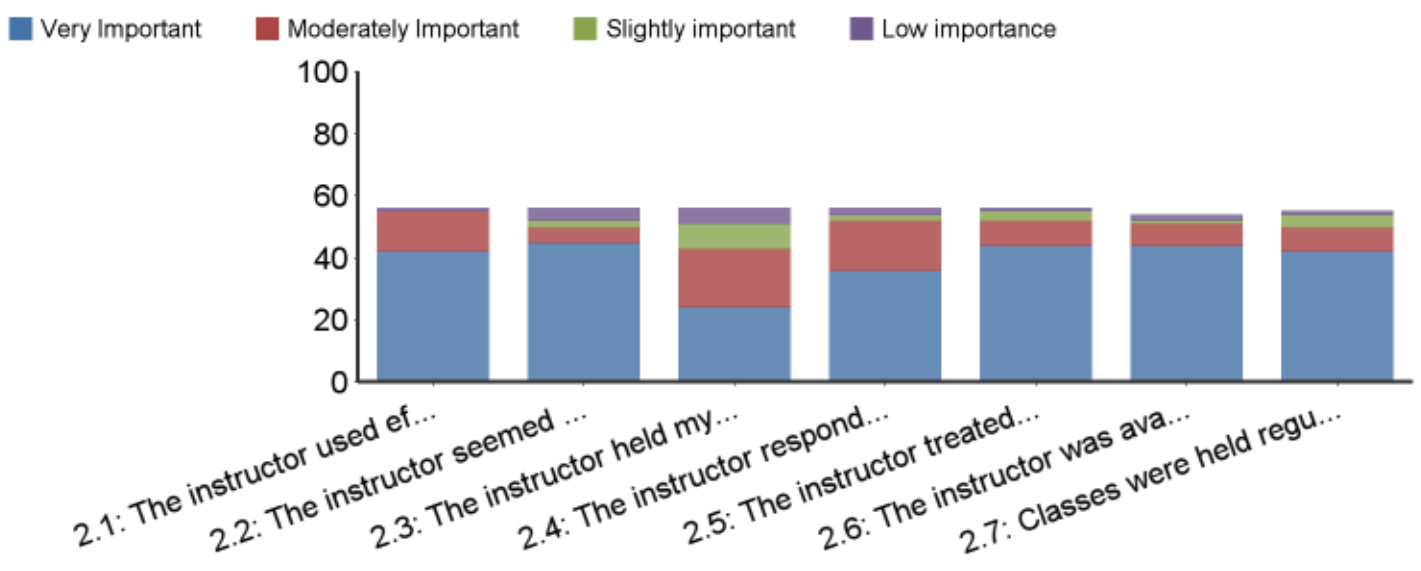

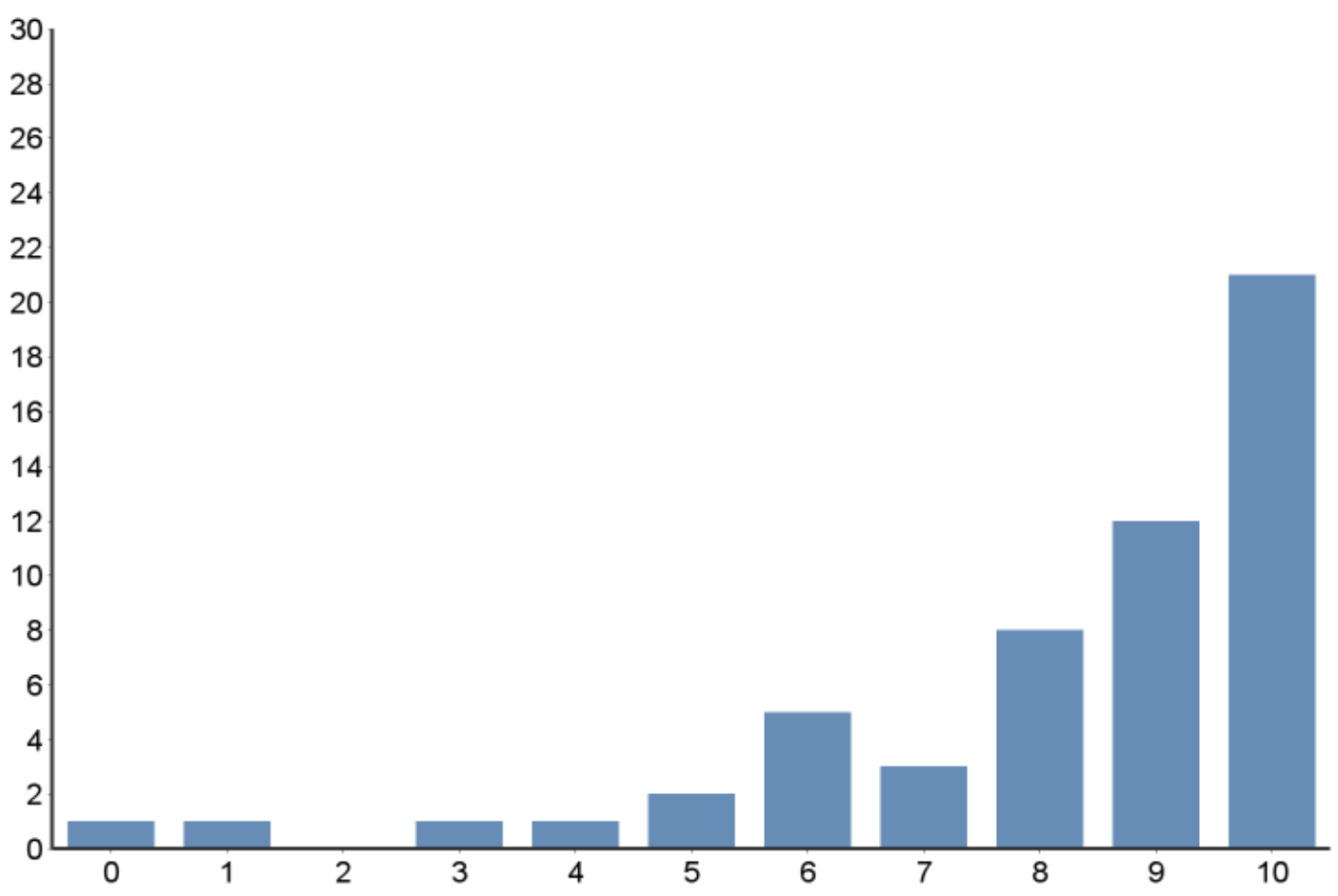

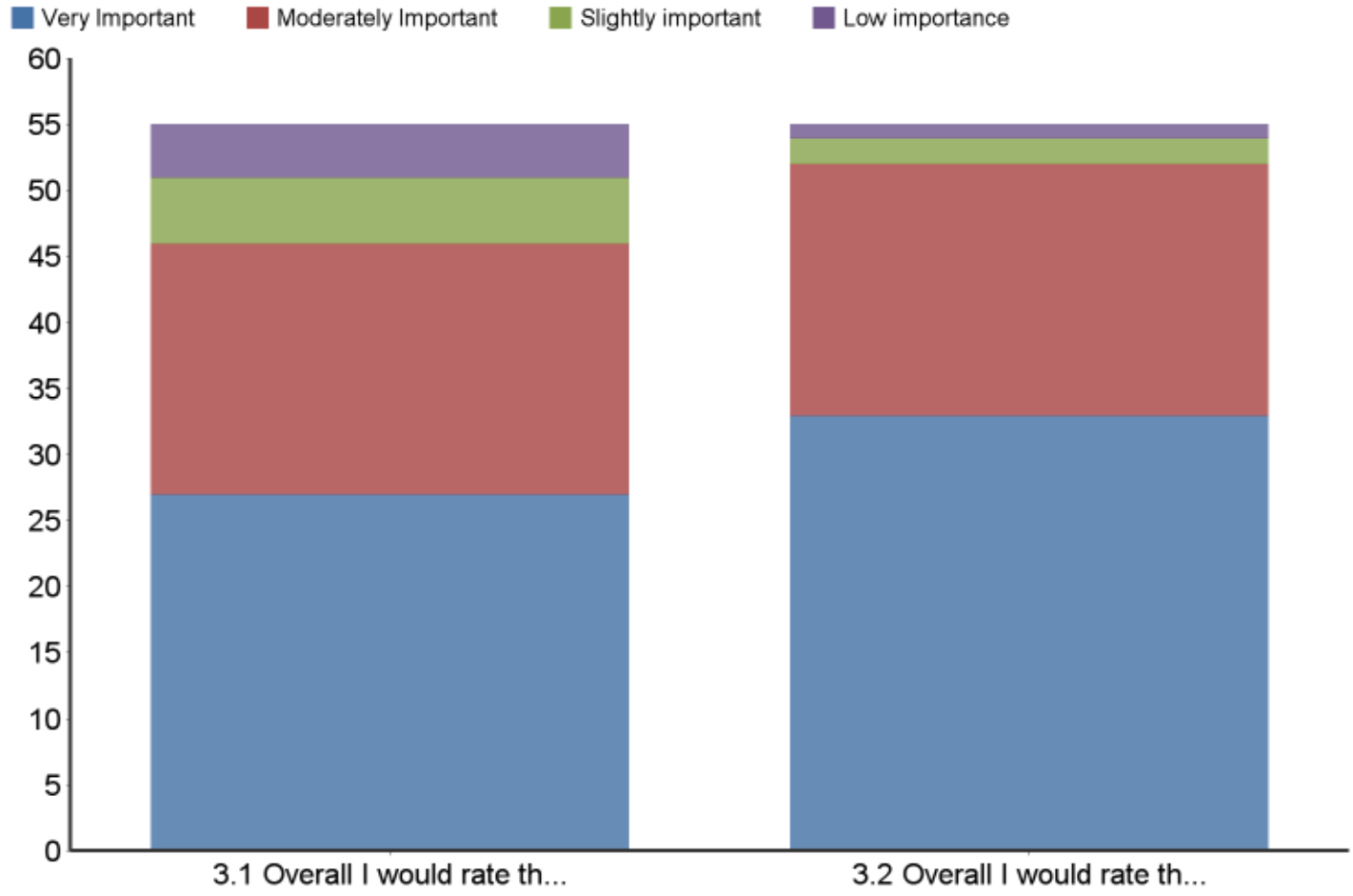

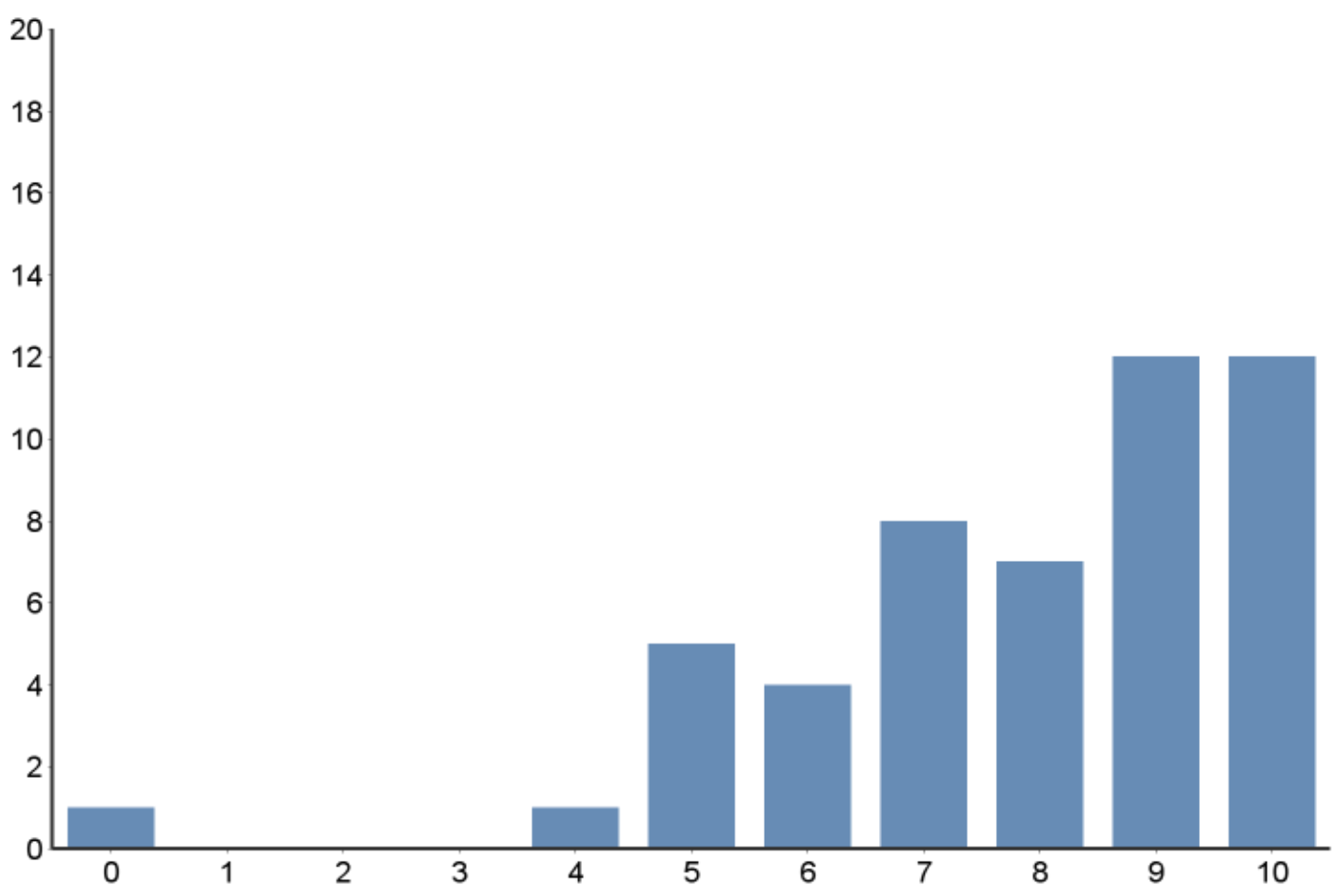

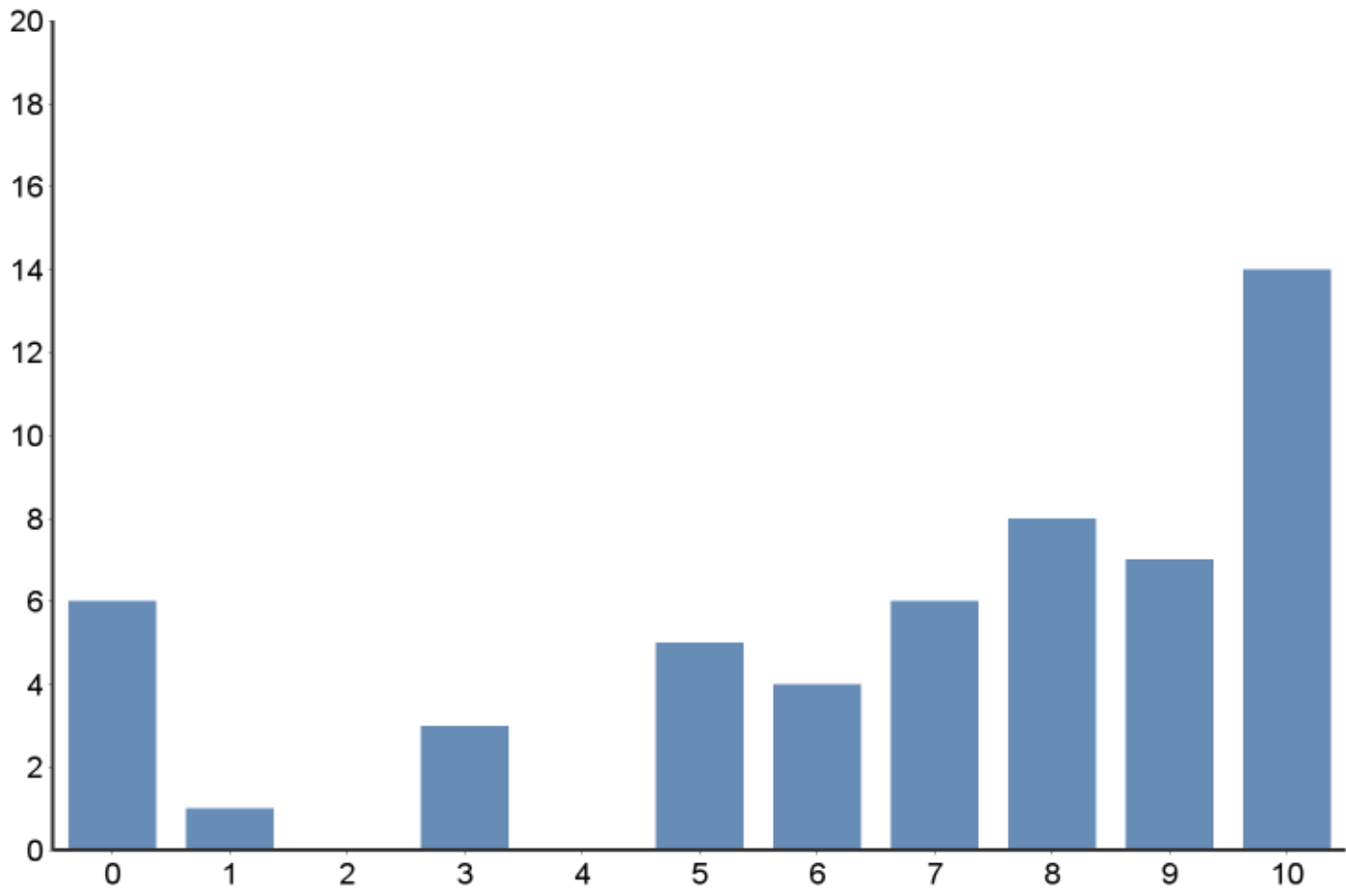

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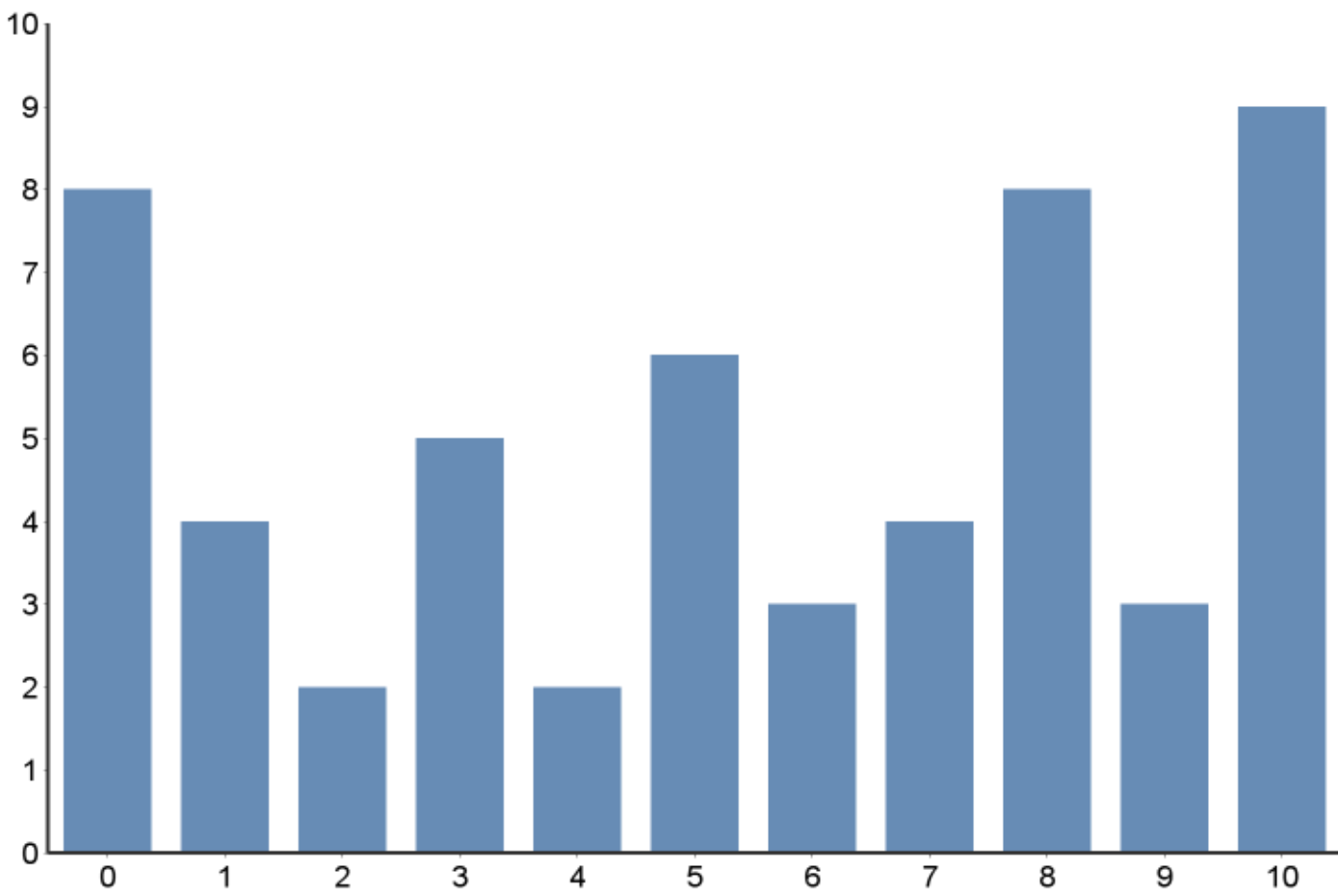

8 How important is evaluation statement 4.2: "I expect to earn a final grade of" and the answers: "A, B, C, D"?

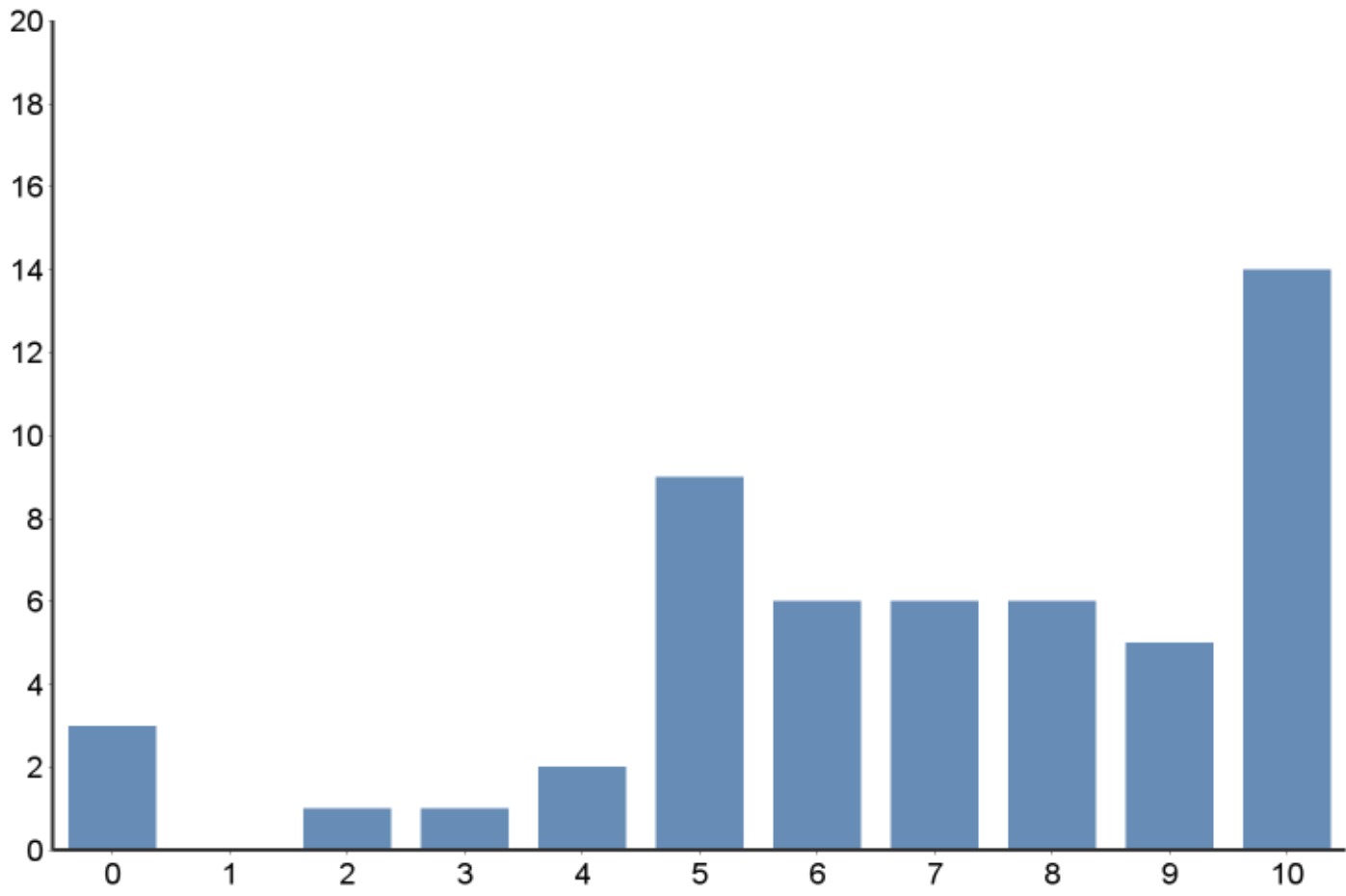

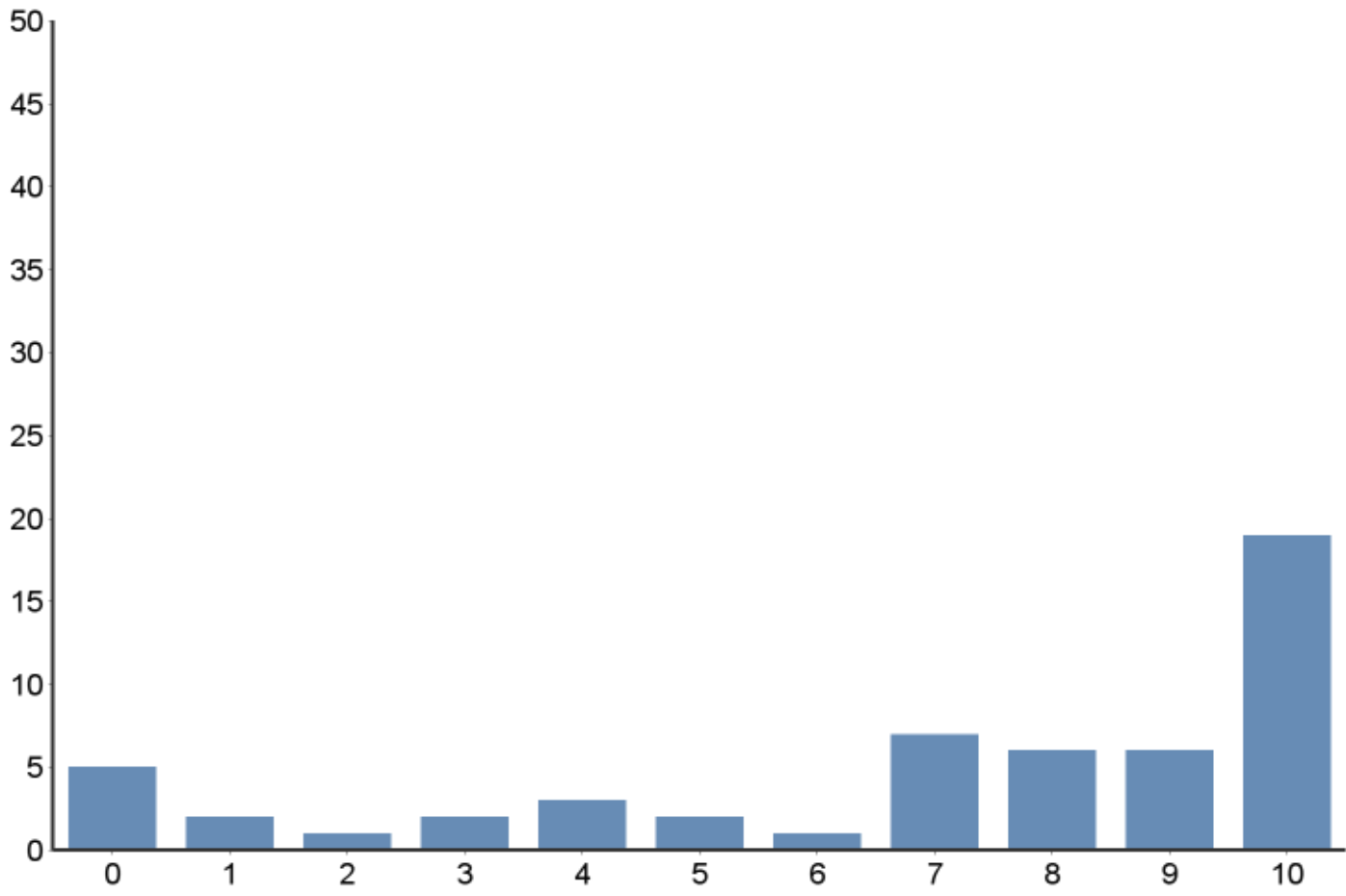
