- 1. Do any of your courses need prerequisites? Include those in your plan.
- 2. Are any of your courses only offered certain semesters?
- 3. You may only earn two "C-" grades in your major courses. If you earn more than two C- grades, you must repeat those
- **4.** If you repeat a course and earned an "A," "B," "C," or "D" grade, you do not earn new credits; the credits are already included in your total. You only earn credits when you repeat "F" grades.
- 5. It is possible to complete all of the courses for your major and your general education requirements and still not have reached 120 credits; to reach the required 120 credits, you may need to take electives.
- **6.** We no longer accept Straighterline courses and all other courses taken elsewhere must be pre-approved and the paperwork filed with the registrar's office, to ensure they will be accepted as transfer credits.
