Faculty Council Proposal Summary

Executive Summary in one paragraph

The Bylaws Committee will reintroduce the proposals from March 2 to faculty for vote with one revision. Given that faculty have overwhelmingly chosen the term "Division" (38 votes) over the term "discipline" (20 votes), our first proposal will only include "Division" as an alternative to "college."

Exact Wording of the Proposed Motion

Faculty Bylaws Committee will bring forward the following proposals to faculty:

Proposal 1: To better reflect the university's new administrative structure, do you agree with replacing "College" with the term "Division"?

Proposal 2: To better reflect the university's new administrative structure, do you agree with the three proposed divisions and SACE?

1. Arts & Humanities,
2. Social Sciences,
3. Science & Technology,
4. School of Adult & Continuing Education (SACE).

Applying the above changes to Sections 4.01(b), 5.09(b, f, g, o, p, q, r, s, and u), 6.01, 6.03, 6.04, 6.06, 6.09, 7.01, 7.03, 7.04, 8.06(d and e), and 13.05 of the Faculty By-Laws.
