Submit Your 2018-2019 FAFSA Now!

As of October 1, the 2018-2019 FAFSA opened for submission. A completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) starts a student's awarding process for the next academic year. Students will need to have FSA IDs and 2016 tax information to complete the application. The IRS Data Retrieval Tool is strongly encouraged to make income reporting easier and more accurate. The Office of Financial Aid is encouraging faculty and staff to assist in spreading the word to students to ensure they are prepared financially for next year.
